



- 2. Article II Recognition and Jurisdiction, Section 5 Remove provision regarding check off dues
- 3. Article III Grievance Procedure, Section 4 Union and Employer both have the right to reject one panel from the Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service
- 4. Article X MCA, Section 3 Employees not required to work for delinquent Employers
- 5. Steward Language (insert) Before starting a job of brickwork, block work, stone work, or Tuckpointing, contractors shall call the Union office requesting a steward be appointed by the Union from the current employees on the job to represent the members of the Union on all jobs of brickwork, stone work, block work, tuckpointing and tile work and shall not be discharged for fulfilling his duties. The caller shall give the location, type of work and time work is to be started.
- 6. Saturday Make Up Day
 - \$5.00 per hour premium for commercial
 - \$2.50 per hour premium for residential
 - Allow volunteer from other crew if not enough work force volunteer available
 - No banking of hours
 - 8-hour shift, weather permitting
 - Same rate of pay for all bricklayers on job
- 7. Corner poles no restrictions
- 8. Pension Offset Language
- 9. Air / Vapor Barrier added to scope of work
- 10. If at any time a contractor becomes a member of the MCA, the terms of our agreement will prevail
- 11. No change to MISL contribution
- 12. No change to MCA contribution
- 13. JATC contribution \$0.75 (\$0.47 to IMI)



- 14. Agree in principal and attorneys to work out language with IMI that 2/3 of funds set to IMI will be returned locally to MISL and JATC
- 15. Agree in principal that competing contracts will not be more favorable
